The camp will be based in Lebanon, at "Laklouk Village Vacances", a secure well known private resort, situated on a plateau at an altitude varying from 1750 to 2000 meters above sea level, at a distance of 62 km away from Beirut. A Rustic place surrounded by pure natural beauty. A must see place for nature lovers and people wishing to get away from the city, where they can enjoy fresh air, rugged beauty, a charming pedestrian village, outdoor activities and cultural arts. Known for its evenings around a campfire, under the stars, "Laklouk Village Vacances "

is keen to offer the best. Our students will spend most of their time in the resort, and will be accommodated in the rooms of one of its 2 hotels. Departure to the camp is from the "Institut Moderne du Liban" school in Beirut on the first day of the camp 8am. Transfer from and to the airport will be provided for international students. In case a student doesn't find a flight to Lebanon on the exact day of the camp, but few days before, he or she will be hosted in the dorms of the secure campus of the school and entertained till the camp starts.



3. WHAT ARE THE Activities

TEAM GAMES

Basketball, football, paintball, volleyball, rugby, beach volleyball, soap soccer

Teaches commitment: When a child signs up for a team, he's committed to stick with it for the full duration of the game. Parents should encourage their kids to honor their commitments.

Creates good losers: It's so important to teach kids that things don't always work out the way they want them to.

skill, and team sports instill that.

Builds friendships: Kids can make friends outside their circle and, from a parental perspective, team games are a great way to get involved in the community.

BEACH AND POOL

Jet ski, flyboard, scuba diving, water parks, ringo, soccer soap, beach volleyball, banana, bucket blast, butterfinger ball, tug of war, water limbo water polo, treasure hunt, water basketball...

Usually, with the scorching summer temperatures, nothing beats a good splash in the swimming pool or in the sea or even in a water park. Kids love the waters.

Hitting the pool and beach may be the top of your kids' to-do list. Don't worry; we've got a ton of cool water games that will keep them occupied and help them make new friends!

During the 14 days the swimming pool of the resort will be at their disposal, besides the trips that will include a day out to the beach enjoying jet skiing, soccer soap, beach volley ball... as well as a day spent in a water park.



EXTREME SPORTS

Wall climbing, rock climbing, flying fox, adventure park, caving, ATV, scuba diving and mountain biking

Kids have different tastes for activities and sports. Some like to climb, others cruise around on their mountain bikes, or spend the entire day learning new tricks on their inline skates.

Many kids are attracted by the high athletic performance that is the main hallmark of extreme sports.

Extreme or not, it's important to encourage kids to express themselves physically, whether their athletic tastes run to the trendy or the traditional. Extreme sports can build self-confidence, relieve stress, and promote physical fitness -- all of which are vital to growing.

Horseback riding: Horseback riding courses will be on school horses. Lessons will be given on almost daily basis in order to let your kids improve their skills either for beginners or familiar with this sport. Day and night riding promenade during full moon will take place.

Tennis: Tennis courses will be given regularly on clay courts in the resort.

5. FREQUENTLY ASKED Questions

CAMP RAGE VS REGULAR SUMMER "COLONIE"

Many families ask us to compare Camp Rage to summer programs offered by their high school (colonie de vacances). Spending a summer away from their school friends offers students an incredible opportunity for independence while trying out new skills, activities and exploring the world outside of their routine. We carefully select highly competent leaders who combine responsibility and professionalism with a proven ability to relate to teens. Camp Rage leaders provide a fresh perspective compared to the teachers and coaches that you and your family have known for years.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE TUITION?

Accommodations in rooms with full board, daily cleaning, laundering of sheets once a week, excursions and entertainment, transportations during the camp, medical insurance and all sports and activities mentioned in the brochure except language courses.

DO YOU HAVE A DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION?

We won't set a deadline, however we advise you to register before May 20th in order to be able to find a place before we are fully booked since we have only one session

WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT DO YOU ACCEPT?

Payments can be made by wire transfer. Sorry, we do not accept credit cards. Call or e-mail us for payment instructions.

WHAT IS THE REFUND POLICY?

Before June 1st, the amount of the full tuition is 50 %refundable but after this date there won't be any refund. There are no refunds for students expelled for inappropriate

behavior. Inappropriate behaviors includes bringing any weapon to camp, fighting, use of illegal drugs or alcohol, smoking, use of fire, vandalism, stealing, repeatedly displaying uncooperative attitude of disrespect for others, and any other action that in the directors' opinion threatens the health, safety or well being of any person or animal, or the smooth operation of the camp.

MEDICAL AND INSURANCE COVERAGE

During the summer camp, all our students will be insured by a private insurance company.

WHAT IS THE FOOD LIKE?

Students will be served 5 meals daily. (Breakfast, lunch, dinner and two snacks) Menu adequate to their ages are set in order to fit all preferences. A daily intercontinental buffet composed of vegetarian and non-vegetarian platters will be offered.

DO STUDENTS NEED A PASSPORT OR A VISA?

For non-Lebanese students visa and passport are required to enter Lebanon. Passports must be minimum 6 months valid. It should have no marks of any entry to Israel.
